

Rules of the KinoKabaret

1. Kicking, hitting, smacking, spitting, punching and all other rude or violent acts against fellow kinoites, host, guests, citizens, animals or equipment, without the purpose of making a movie, is strictly forbidden and will cause immediate expulsion.
2. No smoking or drugs and only very moderate noise or drinking in the KinoLab!
3. Borrowed equipment has to be handled with care and returned intact with all parts. You are responsible for everything and are liable for any damages with your personal insurance. You will leave your passport and sign a form if you borrow equipment from KinoBerlino.
4. Everyone is also responsible for their own safety. If you do stunts at your own risk for a film, you have to be properly insured and trained. KinoBerlino refuses to take responsibility for your safety, so act as grown-ups!
5. The rooms we are working in are kindly given to us by the "ELOK", so please try to tidy up your workspace and don't damage anything. Keep open bottles away from the computers and cameras at all times!
6. KinoBerlino is not responsible for the content of the films presented at its screenings. The organizers can refuse to show a film, or can interrupt a film if they believe it contains hateful, racist, obscene, or illegal material.
7. Films shown at KinoKabarets remain the property of their creator but will be collected and distributed via DVDs and internet. By signing this form, you agree to this and give us permission for royalty-free distribution and TV broadcast. Make sure, you only use footage and music you created yourself or that has a Creative Commons License. Respect the copyrights of musicians and artists!
8. KinoBerlino's logo and all sponsor logos must appear in the credits of any film shown at a screening. Remember to mention everyone involved in your project when inserting the film credits and spell the names correctly.
9. All participants have to register and pay the fee! We do not discuss prices or barter. Don't try! Participants that have not registered properly at the Lab-Office and have not paid the participation fee cannot be granted free entry to the screenings. Wear your badges at all times!
